Award-Winning Project

Areas of work included in this project were the expansion of existing building, including excavation, new foundation and structural systems, roof assemblies, exterior wall assemblies, windows and doors.

Extensive alterations to school interior, including reconfiguration of interior spaces, new partitions and finishes, new MEP, communications, security, and fire protection systems.

LaRosa Building Group and the project team received the Award of Merit for the 2019 CBC Project Team Awards in the K-12 Schools category.









Award-Winning Project

CES/RCA was a new 49,000 SF magnet school facility. Areas of work included in this project were the construction of dance studios, video and multi-media production rooms, band rooms, and make-up rooms, a student lounge, locker room facilities, teacher offices and storage areas, stairways, custodial elevator, and corridors.

Specialty Construction included a black box theater, auditorium, catwalk system, phone/PA closet, alternative electrical service (site generator), and state-of-the art audio/video equipment.

LaRosa Building Group was honored with an ABC Excellence in Construction Award for this project.









This structure is listed on the State of Connecticut Historic Register. The intent of this \$2,041,000. project was to restore it to the splendor that existed when it was built in the 1920's, while updating its electrical and mechanical systems and code compliance to allow it's use and enjoyment by present day theater-goers and students. The work was conducted while the rest of Davidson Hall (CCSU administration) was in full operation with both staff and students. A large amount of work had to be done within "Permit Required Confined Spaces" which accomplished by the through safety training provided by LBG to all contractors on site.









This project consisted of a 19,000 SF interior renovation to a dining facility at Southern Connecticut State University.

Work included selective demolition, concrete infill, misc. metals, rough and finished carpentry, architectural millwork, insulation, roof patching, doors / frames and hardware, acoustical ceilings, new flooring, painting, signage, new kitchen equipment, exhaust hoods, new fire sprinkler system, and HVAC and electrical renovations.

This project was completed on an accelerated schedule during the students' 2 1/2 month summer break from school.









This project was an 80,000 SF renovation to an occupied educational facility. The project brought to the school new classrooms, laboratories, courtyards and a library.

LaRosa Building Group was able to schedule the various trades around the academic schedule of the school, allowing learning to continue uninterrupted throughout the various stages of project completion.









This project was the renovation of the existing dining facility to update the design and functionality of the serving space. The work included the complete removal of existing equipment, flooring, ceilings, walls, and electrical and mechanical systems. Working nearly 24 hours per day, 7 days a week, the space was reconstructed during the university's summer break.
